Competition Rules

- **Costume**
 - Prejudging Part 1: Competitors will wear common sport uniforms (short, top, white thigh-socks) which will be provided for free by the Organizer. Exact sizes of body and feet must be provided on Application Form in advance by the Competitor.
 - Prejudging Part 2: Competitors will wear bikinis of a solid, non- distracting color of their own choice which must conform to accepted standards of taste and decency for the comparisons.
 - Final: Competitors may wear the same bikinis as in Prejudging Part 2 or can be changed for another bikini which could meet with the same standards and requirements as in Prejudging Part 2.
- **Shoes:**
 - Prejudging: Part 1 Competitors may perform the routine in white athletic sport shoes.
 - Prejudging Part 2 and Final: Competitors shall wear high heel stiletto type pumps but transparent, "Glass" looking shoes or pumps are prohibited.
- **Hairstyle:** Competitors may have their hair styled in pretty, treated, modern and feminine design. Hair should not block the evaluation of shoulders and back side during the judgment.
- **Body:** Artificial body coloring may be used provided that it is applied at least twenty-four hours prior to the Prejudging. Tanning lotion and/or creams should be applied evenly over the entire body and in such a manner so as not to cause streaking. The excessive application of oil on the body is strictly prohibited.
- **Jewelry:** Competitors won't wear glasses, watches, bangles, pendants, visible piercing, distracting ornamentation or artificial aids to the figure they may however wear a bracelets, wedding ring, earrings, wigs, necklaces. Having tattoo on body is allowed but won't be counted into evaluation.
- **Available Service:** Hair dresser and make-up artist services are available for a fee on site.
- Competitors will not chew gum or consume food and/or drinks while onstage.

TIMEA MAJOROVA'S FITMODEL WORLD RULES



- *Mandatory posing: Face Front – Face back*

Competition Schedule

The Competition consists of the Prejudging Part 1, Prejudging Part 2 and the Final. In order to give themselves time to warm up and change into their posing attire, competitors should be in the backstage warm-up area at least 30 minutes prior to the start time of the judging of their appearance. All competitors will be solely responsible for ensuring that they are present and prepared to compete when their appearance is called onstage failing which they may be eliminated from the competition.

Prejudging

Part 1: All competitors will be called onstage as a group, in a single line and in numerical order where they will perform choreography together was trained by Sada Goncz star trainer. The judging panel should be given a moment to note the competitor numbers on their score sheet.

All Competitors will be called individually to the center of the stage in numerical order then the competitors will be directed to perform the following poses at centre stage:

- a. Face front
- b. Face back

The judges determine their own individual comparisons which will immediately follow.

Part 2: All competitors will be called onstage one by one to the stage by the Master of Ceremony the Star DJ Attila Varkonyi stage.

Then competitor step back in a single line and in numerical order. After all competitors presented on stage then call them individually to the front where Master of Ceremony will take a short interview with them..

After all interviews Competitors will be called out in small groups (5 athlete in each) to the center of stage for their comparison. The judges will then compare the competitors while they are directed to perform the following poses up to a maximum of five athletes at a time:

- a. Facing front
- b. Quarter turn right
- c. Quarter turn right
- d. Quarter turn right

Each judge is expected to watch all of the comparisons and not just those that a specific judge has requested.

The "Placement System" is used to judge competitors. In this system, each individual judge awards a unique place to each competitor, making sure, that no two or more competitors received the same place.

The head judge may, at her only discretion, determine that there are too many competitors in a competition to allow for a unique placing for each and every competitor. For example, the head judge may direct the judging panel to award only 1st to 12th place. All other competitors will be awarded 13th place. Depending on the schedule however at least the places from 1st place to 12th place have to be awarded by the judging panel.

The scores for the Prejudging will be used to place the competitors from 1st place to last place, or as determined by the head judge from 1st place to at least 12th place. The top 12 competitors from the Prejudging will advance to the Finals.

At the discretion of the Chief Judge, the top 12 finalists may be announced after the Prejudging and before the Finals.

Finals

The top 12 finalists, wearing their finalist competition attire (bikini costume, high hill shoes) will return to the stage in numerical order and in a single line to perform the Quarter turns. Each finalist will be introduced by number, country and name.

This shall be performed at stage center, left and right then the order of the competitors will be reversed and the Quarter turns repeated at the stage center, left and right.

Each judge will mark the competitors in placing of 1st through 12th and will not give more than one athlete the same placing

Scoring

- Judges are strongly reminded that they are judging a Fit Model Competition and not a Bodybuilding or Fitness Physique Competition! Therefore muscularity, vascularity, muscular definition, and/or striations will not be considered acceptable if displayed by a Model Competitor and therefore, must be mark down.
- Instead of looking for muscularity, vascularity and muscular definition judges shall look for the overall aesthetic, not necessarily highly athletic image displayed by the competitor that should demonstrate poise, grace and self confidence.
- The beauty of the physique is the main aspect of judging.
- Competitors should put a high attention on their hair style and make-up as well which will complete the picture of their total appearance.
- This evaluation system mainly adopted from the rules of Bikini Contest of Arnold Classic.

Official Application

- A completed application form which must be sent via email or mail to SBI Promotion Kft but not later than 10th of October 2010.
- A recent picture of the athlete which was shot not earlier than 10 days prior it's sent. The athlete must be appeared by total body in bikini on the photo.
- The Organizer reserve the right to refuse the application, without cause, during the application as well as onsite registration if the athlete was found not to meet with international standard requirements according to photo as well as preparedness at time of registration.
- Unclothed or naked photos won't be accepted for the Application.
- The Organizer reserves the right to reject any of received photos which were qualified as inadequate or visibly modified.
- The confirmation of the application will be sent via email to Applicant therefore it's an obligatory to indicate the name and contact details of Applicant (phone number; email address; etc.) into Application form clearly.

Official Registration

- All competitors are required to present themselves at the Official Athlete Registration which will be taken place from 9.00 to 10.00 am. at designated Official Registration Desk on 16th of October in the Sportmax event hall. Any competitor who fails to attend the Official Athlete Registration at the designated time may be eliminated from the competition.
- All competitors will be required to have in their possession, at the time of the Official Athlete Registration the following items:
 - a. A valid passport; or
 - b. Citizenship papers (ie: birth certificate); or
 - c. Landed immigrant or legal resident papers
- During the Official Athlete Registration, the Organizer will determine the order in which the competitors will appear before the judging panel. The Judges Secretary, or an assistant, will issue each competitor with a competitor number, said number which will be randomly selected by the athlete and which will thereafter correspond to the order in which that competitor will appear before the judging panel. This number must be attached to the left side of the posing bikini, and must be worn throughout the Prejudging and Finals.

Important: Maximum 30 athletes can compete on stage.

Registration fee

- Each Official Competitor must pay the Registration Fee of \$ 50 Euro. This fee is payable to the Organizer during the time of Official Registration at the Official Registration Desk in cash.

Competitors

- Any woman is allowed to apply to the Competition who is over on age of 16 years (at the day of registration) regardless if beginner or already registered athlete of any Federation. There is no separated category according to age or height.

Media Waiver of Liability

- By registering as a competitor at Timea Majorova's FitModel World Competition, the participant agrees that her person and/or likeness may be filmed, videotaped, photographed and/or otherwise recorded, by electronic or other means, for use by the SBI Promotion Kft in promoting the Fitparade and sports.

Waiver of liability

That I understand that in order for me to participate as a Competitor in this Event, I must agree to be bound by this Waiver of Liability and that I do so willingly and of my own free will.

- That I agree to waive any and all claims I may now and in the future have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the SBI Promotion Kft its Event officials, volunteers, agents or representatives, the official hotel and official competition venue and their staff, hereinafter referred to as the "Released Parties", for any personal injury, death and property damages, expenses or loss sustained by me as a result of my participation in the Event due to any cause whatsoever, including, without limitation, negligence or breach of statutory duty on the part of the Released Parties.

- That I agree that medical and personal injury insurance coverage while participating in this Event is solely my responsibility and that I agree to be responsible for and to pay for any and all costs that may arise as a result of my requiring medical and/or other special services and, in any event, should the Released Parties incur any cost for any such services for me personally, I agree to reimburse the Released Parties for all costs of these services as may be incurred by them for my benefit or at my request.
